  - a. \*How did John not cross the street?
  - b. What did John not cross?
- (3) Specify at least one difference between head-to-head movement and other types of movement?
- (4) Account for the ungrammaticality of the following strings:
  - a. \*He<sub>1</sub> killed John<sub>1</sub>.
  - b. \*He<sub>1</sub> killed him<sub>1</sub>.
- (5) Demonstrate the thesis that semantic interpretation in natural language is a function of syntactic structure?
- (6) Give three common properties between determiner phrases and clauses?
- (7) Discuss the salient properties of the following construction:
  - a. I have never met so stubborn a man to persuade.
- (8) Which of the following sentences is ambiguous? Explain the ambiguity? What can you draw from it about the nature of tense?
  - a. Bill said that Diana was sick.
  - b. Bill said that Mary is sick.
- (9) Explain why the following string is ill-formed?
  - a. \*What John wrote?
  - b. Exemplify five types of complements in English?
- (10) What are the basic lexical categories and functional categories? Provide the definition of the lexical categories in terms of features?
- (11) State the Principle of compositionality and illustrate it with an example?
- (12) Explain the ungrammaticality of the following strings:
  - a. \*John considers Bill sick
  - b. \*John saw Diana tall.

- (13) Specify four syntactic positions of adverbials for English sentences with examples?
